ALUMNI | **Frank Kabbes**

Frank Kabbes graduated from St. Anthony High School in 1950 and received his undergraduate degree from Quincy College. He was drafted by the New York Yankees and then the U.S. Army. After his discharge from the army, he resumed his baseball career. After retiring from baseball, Frank worked at the Ford Motor Company before returning to Effingham to begin a 40-year career at Effingham State Bank. Frank eventually served as President and Chairman of the Board; he was involved in the early stages of the bank's transition to what is today Midland States Bank. Frank has actively supported St. Anthony by coaching baseball, supporting picnic financial responsibilities/transactions, and fundraising. Additionally, he has been involved in wider community efforts that directly and indirectly contribute to St. Anthony parish and schools which culminated in his recognition as the Effingham Citizen of the Year in 1999.



FACULTY, STAFF, OR COACH | **Patti Devall**

Patti Devall ('69) dedicated 41 years of service to St. Anthony Grade School as a primary teacher. Throughout those years, she inspired hundreds of students and parents alike.
