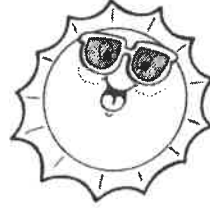

Identifying & Writing Numbers

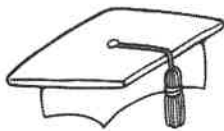
Identifying & Writing Letters

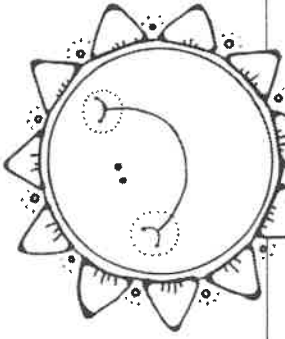

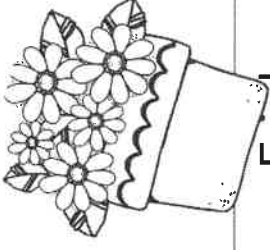
